

Craft: “When I Grow Up . . .” Book

Items Needed:

- General: Crayons or Markers, Stapler, Glue, Decorations
- Per Child: 1 Sheet of Construction Paper, 4 Sheets of White Copy Paper

Instructions:

- Tell the children that they will be creating a books about what they think God may want them to do when they grow up.
- Have each child cut the white copy paper in half.
- Staple the pages together along the longest side.
- Fold the construction paper in half and have each child decorate his or her paper. (It is easier to decorate the cover prior to gluing it onto the book.)
- Tell the children that these are the covers for their books and have them each write a title on the cover.
- Put glue on the outer pages of the stapled white copy paper and wrap the construction paper around the stapled pages to make a cover for the book.
- Tell the children that God has special things for them to do as they live their lives and they can pray for God to show them what special things He has for them to do.
