

# Craft: “Wonderful Me” Frame

## Items Needed:

- General: Glue, Crayons or Markers
- Per Child: 8 Craft Sticks, 1/4 Sheet of White Paper or a Photo of Each Child and 1 Half Sheet of Construction Paper

## Instructions:

- Give each child eight craft sticks and one sheet of white paper or his or her photo.
- In the middle of one of the craft sticks have the children write “Wonderful,” and on another have them write “Me.”
- If using white paper, have each child draw a portrait of him or herself, leaving room around the edges for a frame made out of the craft sticks.
- If they are using photographs, have each child glue the half sheet of construction paper to the back of his or her photo if they do not have room on the photo for a frame.
- They will glue two craft sticks on each side of their portrait or photo and then two on the top and bottom. The sticks with the words “Wonderful Me” need to be at the top or bottom of the frame.
- Tell the children to write or draw something positive about himself or herself on the other craft sticks and then decorate their frames.
